

Forestart (RoP 40)

Wild cherry is an ecologically important native species that produces beautiful high-value timber. The RoP 40 orchard at Forestart produces *Qualified* seed for western Britain.

Where to plant

Wild cherry shows moderate levels of local adaptation. The plus trees in this orchard are selected from Region of Provenance 40 and material can be planted across the majority of Great Britain. No recommendations are made for the island of Ireland, please seek country-specific advice.
